The term Phonics during the 19th century and into the 1970's was used as a synonym of phonetics. The use of the term in reference to the method of teaching is dated to 1901 by the Oxford English Dictionary. The relationship between sounds and letters is the backbone of traditional phonics.

The goal of phonics instruction is to help children learn the alphabetic principle—the idea that letters represent the sounds language and that there is an organized, logical and predictable relationship between written letters and spoken sounds.

This year 'Phonics competition' was held on 4th of November, for which students were given regular practice at school, teachers asked each student to read the phonic sound of the letters.
